

PUBLIC NOTICE OF INTENT TO INCREASE RATES

Texas Gas Service Company, a division of ONEOK, Inc. ("Company"), hereby gives notice to the public that on June 23, 2011, it filed with the Railroad Commission of Texas ("Commission") a Statement of Intent to Increase Rates ("Statement of Intent") in the Environs of its North Texas Service Area ("NTSA"), which includes the unincorporated areas surrounding the cities of Breckenridge, Graham, Jacksboro, Bryson, Mineral Wells, Graford, Millsap, Weatherford, Aledo, Hudson Oaks, and Willow Park, Texas, as well as the unincorporated cities of Jermyn, Palo Pinto, Whitt, Perrin, Punkin Center, and Possum Kingdom, Texas. The Statement of Intent filing made by the Company seeks to increase rates in the NTSA Environs to bring them in line with the increase in rates recently approved by the NTSA Cities. The proposed increase will take effect on December 25, 2011.

The proposed changes to Texas Gas' tariffs will affect all of the approximately 1,858 general service customers in the NTSA Environs, including 1,644 residential customers, 180 commercial customers, 1 large volume commercial customer, 1 industrial customer, 1 large volume industrial customer, and 31 public authority customers. The proposed rates will increase the Company's annual revenues in the NTSA Environs by approximately \$77,148, which represents an increase (including gas costs) of approximately 0.4873% for the NTSA, and 5.1741% strictly for the NTSA Environs. Because this amount is less than \$100,000, it does not represent a "major change" as that term is defined by TEX. UTIL. CODE ANN. § 104.101. To achieve these increased revenues, the Company proposes to increase the volumetric rate for the customers in its NTSA Environs by \$ 0.0576 per hundred cubic feet (Ccf). The following table demonstrates the proposed rates and average monthly bill increase for each class of customers affected in the NTSA environs.

Note: The average monthly bill increase includes a 12 month average gas cost of \$0.5338 per Ccf and excludes revenue related taxes. The bill increase is based upon an average monthly consumption of 40 Ccf for residential customers, 187 Ccf for commercial customers, 5,941 Ccf for large volume commercial customers, 1,824 Ccf for industrial customers, 1,531 Ccf for large volume industrial customers, 502 Ccf for public authority customers and 9,208 for large volume public authority customers.

In addition, the Company seeks to recover all rate case expenses as allowed by law. The exact amount of rate case expenses will not be known until the case is completed. Finally, by this filing the Company withdraws its Cost of Service Adjustment tariff applicable to the NTSA Environs.

This notice is given pursuant to the notice requirements of Tex. Util. Code Ann. § 104.103 and 16 Tex. Admin. Code § 7.230.
