

Notice of Interim Rate Adjustment Tariff

Texas Gas Service Company, a division of ONEOK, Inc. (“Company”), hereby gives notice of its intent to implement a Interim Rate Adjustment (“IRA”) tariff for gas services provided to approximately 2,885 residential, 196 commercial and church, 24 industrial, 36 public authority, and 27 transportation customers within the environs of the Company's Rio Grande Valley Service Area, which includes the environs of, Alamo, Alton, Bayview, Brownsville, Combes, Donna, Edcouch, Edinburg, Elsa, Harlingen, Hidalgo, La Feria, La Joya, La Villa, Laguna Heights, Laguna Vista, Los Fresnos, Lyford, McAllen, Mercedes, Mission, Monte Alto, Olmito, Palm Valley, Palmhurst, Palmview, Penitas, Pharr, Port Isabel, Primera, Progreso, Rancho Viejo, Raymondville, Rio Hondo, San Benito, San Carlos, San Juan, Santa Rosa, and Weslaco, Texas (“Environs”). The IRA tariff was filed with the Railroad Commission of Texas on July 7, 2010, and the proposed effective date of the IRA tariff is September 5, 2010.

The IRA tariff implements an interim rate adjustment pursuant to TEX. UTIL. CODE ANN. §104.301. The interim rate adjustment will allow the Company to recover the incremental cost of its new investment made in the Rio Grande Valley Service Area between December 31, 2007 and December 31, 2009. The Company expects that its revenues from Environs customers will increase by \$75,958 as a result of the IRA tariff. Pursuant to Tex. Util. Code Ann. 104.101, the proposed increase does not constitute a major change in the Company’s rates.

The IRA tariff will increase the monthly average bill for all residential, commercial, church, industrial, public authority and transportation customers within the environs of the Company’s Rio Grande Valley Service Area. The average increase that each of these customer classes will experience, excluding revenue-related fees and taxes, is shown in the table below.
