Oncourse shall ask the customer if they wish to know about Oncourse's percentage of accepted claims based upon data relating to services, programs or products provided by Oncourse to ONE Gas, Inc.'s customers (Oklahoma Natural Gas, Texas Gas Service and Kansas Gas Service customers) at the time they are requesting the service, program or product and will provide that information to the customer. Customers who rent their residence shall not be eligible for certain services, programs or products offered by Oncourse (e.g., sewer line, gas line, water line, etc.) Since it is likely the landlord would be responsible for repairing the covered items. Before enrolling, customers should review their homeowner's insurance policy terms to see if they already have coverage.
