

Before The Storm

- Check around your natural gas meter and remove any objects that could be blown into or against your natural gas meter by strong winds or pushed into the meter by heavy rain and flooding.
- Remove any branches or other objects that could fall onto and cause damage to your meter.

After The Storm

- If you smell natural gas or your meter has been damaged, leave the area immediately, then call 911 and us at 800-959-5325.
- If your service was interrupted during the storm, do not attempt to turn your natural gas meter back on. Call our customer service line at 800-700-2443.
- Contact 811 before you begin debris cleanup if it involves digging.
